# STREET VIEW

The Eng-Skell building last month exhibited ownership stability. This month we look at 1235 Mission, which illustrates the more common volatility of business.

Street View (cont.)

In 1928, Mangrum and Otter, wholesalers of restaurant equipment and furnishings (including tiles) had Bliss and Fairweather design this replacement for their building at 827 Mission, and decorated the front with what John King calls a tiled "polychromatic extravaganza". In 1929 they merged with Holbrook, Merrill, and Stetson; old catalogs on eBay call this "The West's most beautiful wholesale establishment". By the 1940s, after another merger, the building was let go. By the late 1980's Barker Pacific owned it and leased it to the city, which bought it in 2012 for the Human Services Agency.
